It was great fun and very re-

garding to see decades of dirt making many tombs unreadable to shiny clean.

Thanks to the volunteers and our friends from UWF.

On March 25th another Tombstone cleaning session took place. During the week of 3/5, Monument Conservation Collaborative (recognized experts in making monument repairs) repaired 11markers, ledger and urns in our historic cemetery. We plan to do more repairs in the future.

Members should be aware that purchasing a cemetery plot in advance is not only a benefit to your family, but good economics in that it is \$1,500 less than purchasing after death. If you need information about burial at the Temple cemetery, contact Ray Engel.
