We are continuing to enjoy a lot of growth. It seems that at every board meeting we have a new application for membership to approve. Rabbi Joel is doing a fantastic job at outreach in the entire community while also offering our members a wide array of activities in which to participate in, whether it is Torah on Tap, Torah study, poetry or the like. We are now in the midst of our summer services that begin at 6:00 pm, followed by a covered dish dinner. I hope that everyone participates.

Financially we are doing fairly well, although we can always do better. Most of you have paid all your pledges towards the renovation.

As far as fundraising goes, we are quickly approaching the Temple Beth El poker tournament.
