Dear Community,

April passed with lots of Matzah and events! Special thank you all for supporting the Pensacola Jewish Federation by participating our annual Jazz Shabbat! Certainly became one of my two favorite Shabbats!

Thanks for all the awesome volunteers who came on Good Deeds Day to the Humane Society and gave away 2 hours free to our cute friends! They highly appreciate it!

Participating at the Yoms this year was very special to me. During the Yoms in Israel everything is closed. Nothing on TV or on the radio except for Holocaust movies or memorial ceremonies. You can feel it in the air. Here where everything runs as usual, I had the honor of organizing those events. Thank you all who understood the importance

of those three days, Yom Hashoah which reminded us about our nation's past, Yom Hazikaron, day of appreciation for those who lost their life so we can celebrate Yom Haatzmaut free in our country. We'll Never Forget!

We soon will be celebrating Lag B'Omer, Lag B'Omer is a minor holiday that occurs on the 33rd day of the Omer, the 49-day period between Passover and Shavuot. The holiday teaches us Hahavat Chinam; free love as the story tells how Rabbi Akivah's students died because they had Sinhat Chinam, free hate for each other. The fire we all celebrated at the PJF Lag B'Omer Campout was the way to pass the message about the Bar Kochvah rebellion against the Romans.

Shavuot comes right after, the holiday of cheese cakes. But for me Shavuot is all about water. There is a custom called the holiday of water. It came up in south Africa and made an Aliah to Israel. Some people say that if you pour water on people during Shavuot they won't be harmed this coming year. Others say that they used water to wake up all the people who stayed up all night. It's also Hag Matan Torah, the time which God gave us the Torah, and the Torah was compared to water, so in that way we celebrate Torah. When I was a kid, you couldn't pass the street without getting wet. So get yourself ready! This holiday will be filled with water on May 20th at the seashore national park.

Every end it's a new beginning! Our PJF TV show night continue with a new TV Show! Srugim! The series deals with a group of singles from the national religious sector. Since they were not married, they found it difficult to integrate within the existing religious framework and as a result have been labeled under the sub-society known as the "Jerusalem swamp" in Katamon, made up of people in the same status. The series presented various points of friction in the national-religious society — old bachelors, various problems in marriage, homosexuality, divorce, etc. - and got lots of comments from the religious sector. After a successful pilot we'll meet every week for another episode of Srugim!

With that note I'll remind everyone that Fouda, the TV show that brings the chaos of the West Bank to television is starting a new season on May 24th.
