Congregation of Temple Beth El:

As many of you know, Lewis and Belle Bear have agreed to match up to \$500,000 for any monies received before December 1, 2018 in order to establish a permanent maintenance fund for Temple Beth El. Without going into every detail of the agreement, the purpose of the fund is not to support the general maintenance of the temple on a yearly basis, but is a reserve for future capital expenditures that may not be expected.

To date, we have raised approximately \$400,000 towards our goal. This leaves us \$100,000 short in establishing a captured fund of \$1,000,000.00. I have quietly solicited contributions from several key members of our congregation and I thank them for their generosity. However, I must now call upon the rest of our congregation to make up the difference, since this is an opportunity we must not miss.

As president of our congregation, I want to thank Lewis and Belle, not only for their generosity, but for their foresight in protecting this facility for years to come.

I know that many of you may not have the financial ability to make large donations but now is the time for everyone to step up to the plate and send in a check to the attention of Kathy, payable to Temple Beth El and **with "Bear Maintenance Fund" in the memo line so that we can reach** our goal of \$500,000 before December of 2018.

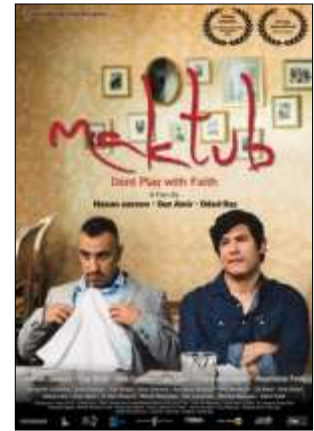
