In Memoriam

It is with a heavy heart that we share news of the passing of Temple Beth El's longtime spiritual leader and Rabbi Emeritus, Rabbi N. William Schwartz. The congregation extends its condolences to Rabbi Schwartz's loving wife Elaine, his children Marty, Debbie, and Danny, and to the many members of our **Temple community whose lives were touched by Rabbi Schwartz's wisdom and kindness.**

Rabbi N. William Schwartz was raised in Scranton, PA. A graduate of The College of William and Mary, he received rabbinic ordination from Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion. Rabbi Schwartz was a veteran of the United States Army, having served in Europe during World War II. He served Temple Beth El for a generation from 1962 until 1990. During these years Rabbi Schwartz brought meaning to worship and many life-cycle events.

He was also a mainstay of the Pensacola clergy community, playing an instrumental role in initiating the Interfaith Thanksgiving service, a tradition which continues to this day. He also organized the largest community Passover Seder in the history of Pensacola, an event so large it was held at the Municipal Auditorium downtown.

Funeral Services were held at Veterans Cemetery in Lake Worth FL, Thursday, July 29 at 9:30 a.m. Condolences can be sent to Elaine Schwartz, 7111 Demedici Circle, Delray Beach, FL. 33446.

Zichrono L'vracha — May Rabbi Schwartz be long remembered for his years of service and may his memory be a source of comfort and blessing.
